

Final state exam – Mezinárodní vztahy/International Relations

Schedule of the exam

1) Defence of the MA thesis (approx. 15-20 minutes)

- Short presentation of the thesis by the student – information about the research objectives, theoretical and methodological approach, and the main findings (4-5 minutes)
- Short presentation of the main points from the reviews by the previously appointed members of the committee (4-5 minutes for both reviews altogether)
- Reaction of the student to the reviews and a possible related discussion with the committee (8-10 minutes)

2) Exam from International Relations (approx. 10-12 minutes)

3) Exam from the elected subject – European Union, International Institutions, International Law, or International Economic Relations (approx. 10-12 minutes)

In parts 2 and 3, a student will draw one question in each of the parts, and answer this question, together with a number of specific and related questions posed by the members of the committee.

Total time = approx. 45 minutes

Notes:

The lengths of the individual parts of the exam are only indicative and may be slightly different.

The final state exam of students who began their studies earlier than in the academic year 2021/2022 has four parts: in addition to the defence of the MA thesis and the exams from International Relations and the elected subject, these students also take a mandatory exam from European Studies.
